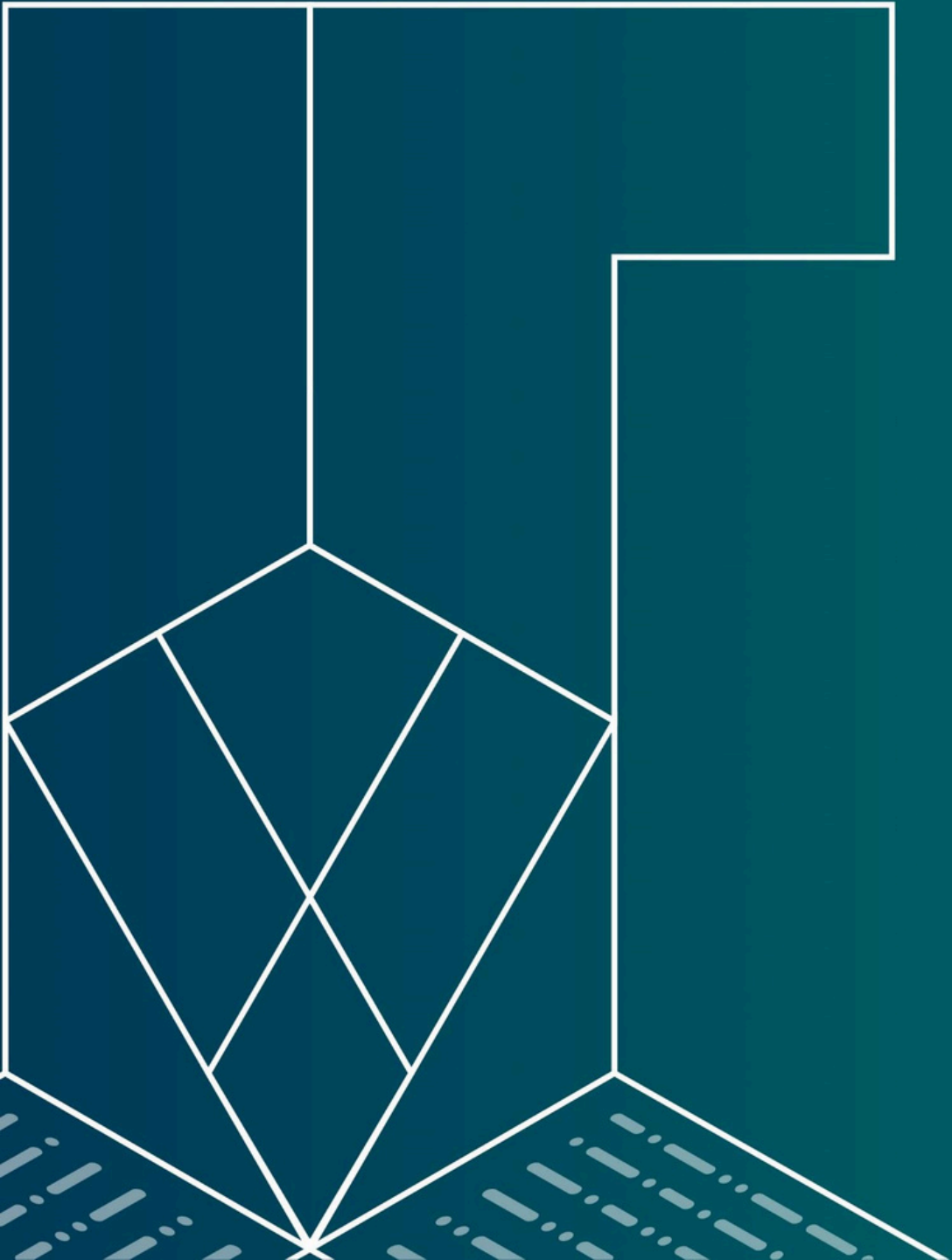

Arrive at Imam Khomeini International Airport(IKA)and go through the immigration and customs procedures.

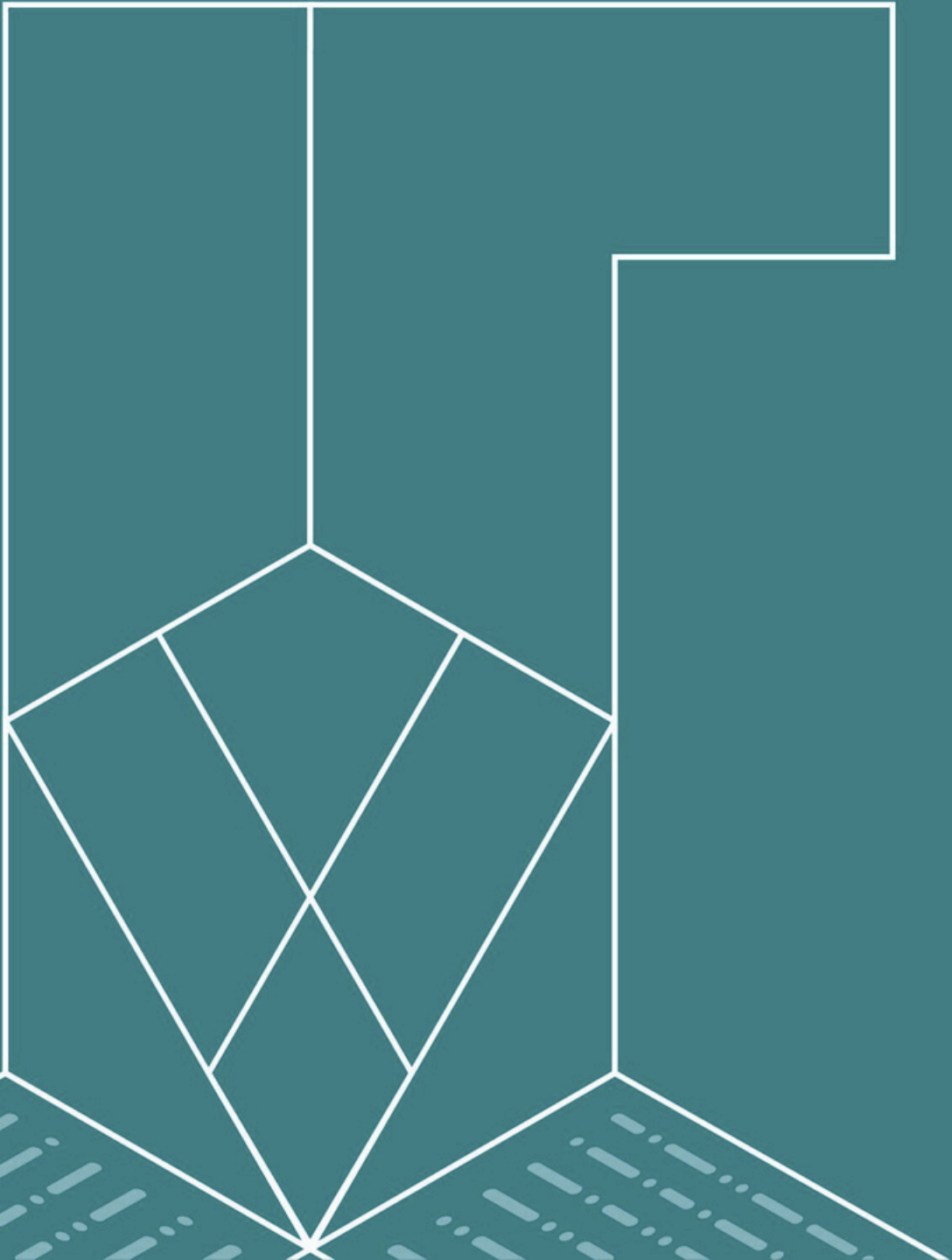
DO'S

- Check your visa requirements before traveling to Iran. You can check the latest visa information on the website of the Iranian Ministry of Foreign Affairs. Buy a SIM card at the airport if you want to use your phone in Iran. You can find different operators such as Irancell and MCI at the arrival hall. You will need your passport and visa to buy a SIM card.
- Exchange some money at the airport if you need Iranian rials. You can find exchange offices at the arrival hall. You can also exchange currencies at the Exchange Office in Pardis Technology Park. Use a reliable transportation service to get to your hotel. You can choose from Snapp or Tapsi (Iranian versions of Uber), and airport taxi service. You can book Snapp or Tapsi online or through their apps, but you will need an Iranian phone number and internet connection. You can find an airport taxi service at the exit of the arrival hall.



DONT'S

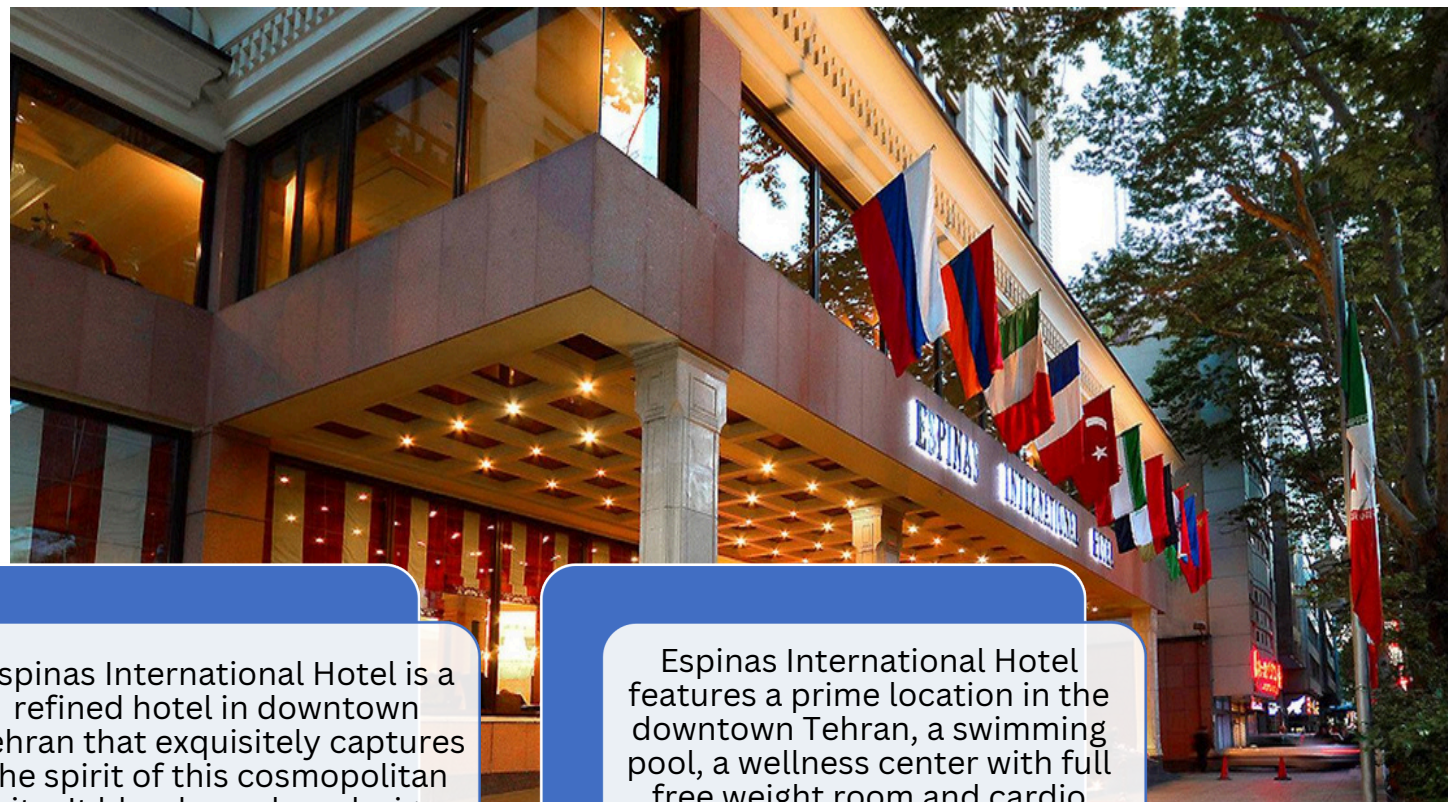
- Don't bring any prohibited items to Iran such as alcohol, pork, drugs, etc. These items are illegal in Iran and may result in confiscation or fines.

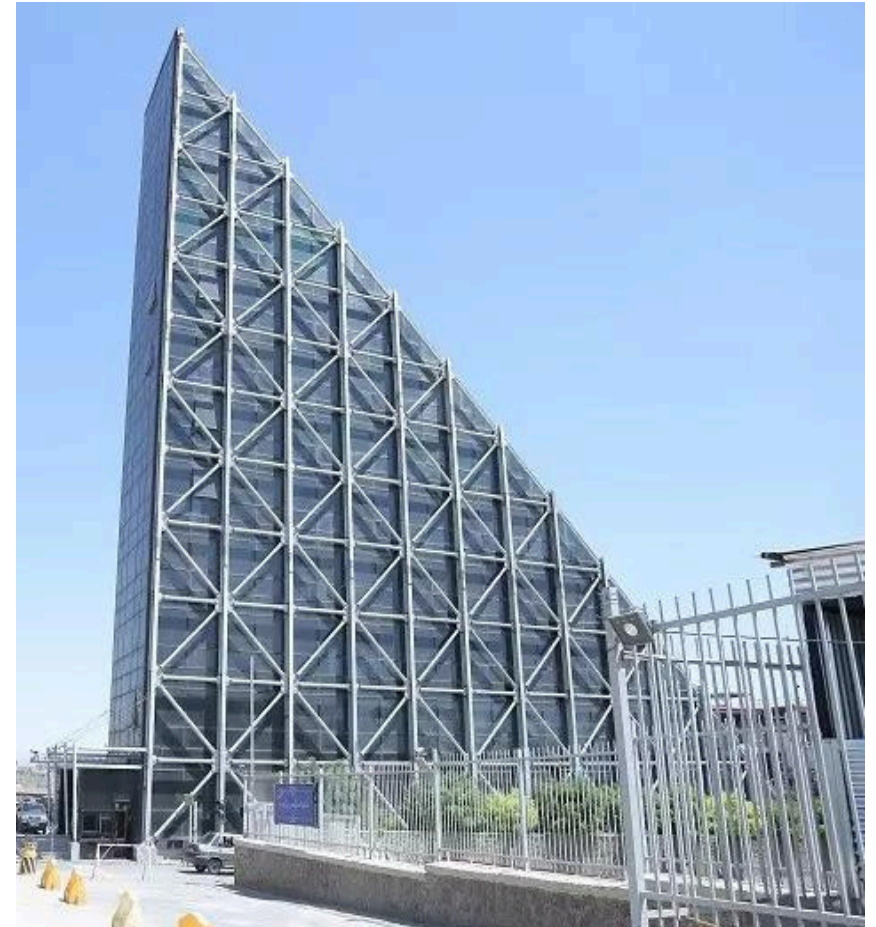
GETTING TO INOTEX 2026

Here is a possible way to tell them how they can go from their hotels to Pardis Technology Park:

Option A (Recommended): You can use online taxi services such as Snapp or Tapsi, which are more convenient and more reliable than regular taxis, though a bit more expensive. You can download their apps on your smartphone and choose Pardis Technology Park as your destination. It will cost you around 3,000,000 rials (about 3 USD) for a one-way trip. You can share the ride with up to three people.

Option B: You can take the Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) from your hotel to Tehranpars station (Red Line). Then you can take a taxi or a van from the station to Pardis Technology Park. It will cost you around 250,000 rials (about 25 cents) for a one-way trip. Make sure you tell the driver to drop you off at Pardis Technology Park, not Pardis town.

Option C: You can take the metro from your hotel to Nobonyad (Line 3) or Farhangsara (Line 2) stations. Then you can take a taxi or a van from the station to Pardis Technology Park. It will cost you around 250,000 rials (about 25 Cents) for a one-way trip. Make sure you tell the driver to drop you off at Pardis Technology Park, not Pardis town.

نقشه‌ی خطوط سامانه تندرو تهران

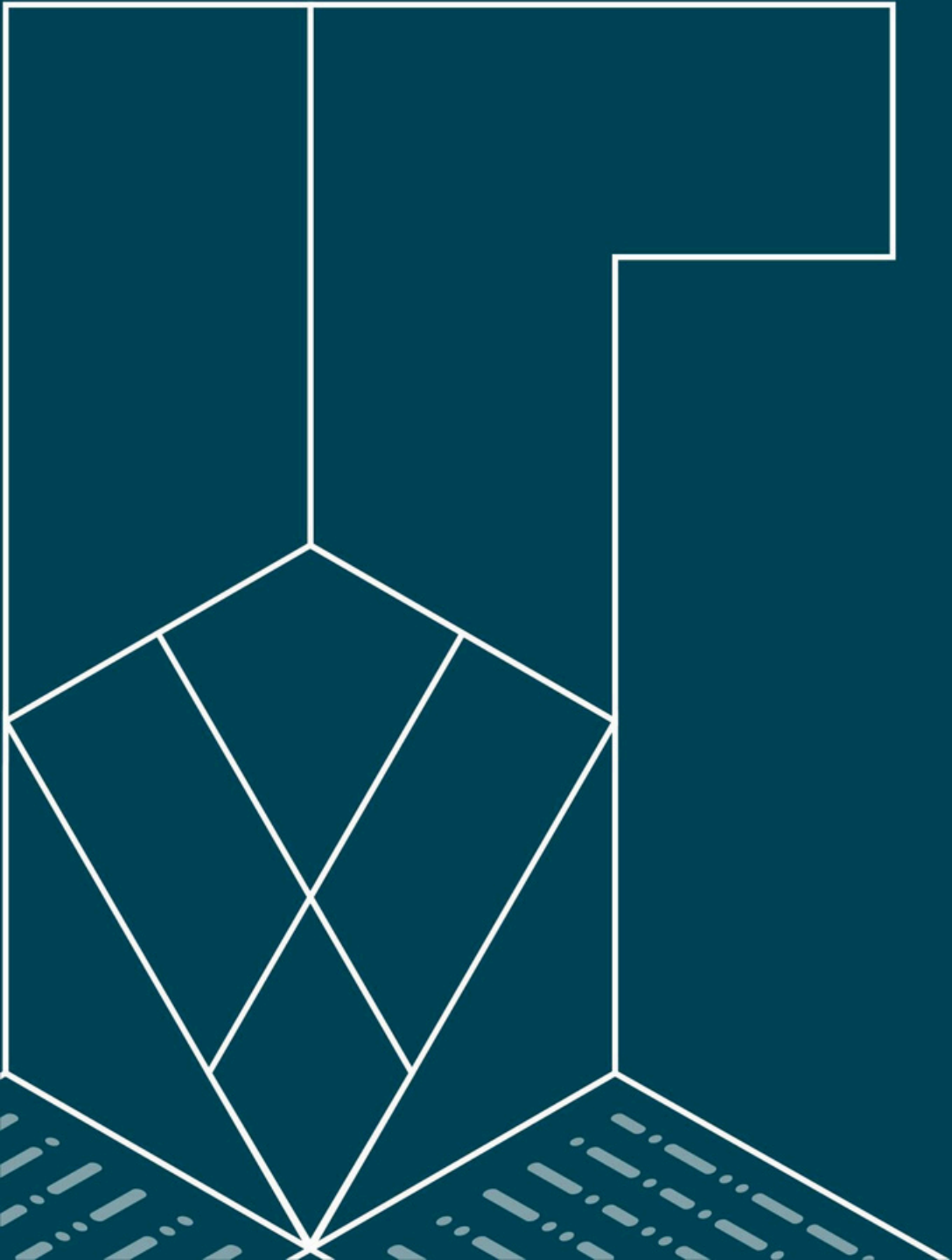
Tehran BRT Map

Prices in Tehran

You might be wondering how much money you will need to spend on food, drinks, and accommodations. The good news is that Tehran is generally cheaper than other major cities in the world, especially in Western countries. You can find a variety of restaurants, cafes, and street food stalls that offer delicious and affordable meals. Drinks such as tea, coffee, and soft drinks are also inexpensive and widely available. For accommodations, you can choose from different options such as hotels, hostels, guesthouses, and apartments. Depending on your budget and preferences, you can find a comfortable and convenient place to stay in Tehran. However, one thing to keep in mind is that prices are not fixed in Tehran. In bazaars and markets, where you can buy souvenirs, handicrafts, carpets, spices, and other goods, you will need to bargain with the sellers to get a fair price. Negotiating prices is a common practice in Iran and part of the culture. Don't be shy to haggle and enjoy the experience.

Cultural Norms of Iran

- Iranians may be more conservative in their dress code, particularly for women. Loose-fitting clothes that cover arms and legs are recommended, especially when visiting religious sites. Alcohol is illegal in Iran, and public
- displays of affection or intimacy are not tolerated. Iranians are very hospitable and may invite you to their homes
- for a meal or tea, but also be prepared for a lot of ta'arof, a form of exaggerated politeness that involves offering and refusing things several times before reaching an agreement.
